12-19 YEAR OLDS
MUST BE A MEMBER OF A GOLF CLUB

UNDER 11'S
NO HANDICAP OR GOLF CLUB MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED

DISCOUNTED ENTRIES CLOSE THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO AN EVENT
WITH THE DRAW AVAILABLE ONE WEEK PRIOR VIA THE TOURNAMENT
MANAGEMENT SECTION OF THE WEBSITE

ENTRY FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE OR TRANSFERRABLE 3 WEEKS
FROM THE START OF AN EVENT. IF ANY EVENT IS CANCELLED DUE TO
ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS, OR ANY OTHER VALID REASON,
THE ENTRY FEES WILL AUTOMATICALLY TRANSFER TO A
RESCHEDULED DATE. CANCELLATION REQUESTS PRIOR TO 3 WEEKS
FROM AN EVENT WILL HAVE A 10% CHARGE TO COVER MERCHANT
FEES. ENTRY REQUESTS AFTER 3 WEEKS FROM AN EVENT WILL HAVE
AN ADDITIONAL 10% FEE

INDIVIDUAL PRIZES

IN EACH AGE CATEGORY TROPHIES, MEDALS OR PRIZES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE TOP 4 COMPETITORS & GIRLS CHAMPION.

FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY THE TOP 4 GROSS SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS & FOR THE UNDER 19 CATEGORIES THE TOP 2 STABLEFORD SCRATCH SCORES AND TOP 2 STABLEFORD SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS.

THE GIRLS CHAMPION IN THE U19 CATEGORIES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE BEST STABLEFORD POINTS & IN THE U9 CATEGORY THE GIRLS CHAMPION WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE TOP GROSS SCORE.

TEAM PRIZES

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEAM COMPETITION EACH TEAM MUST CONSIST OF 2 PLAYERS, BOTH WITHIN THE SAME AGE CATEGORY AND SCHOOL.

THE WINNING TEAM/S WILL BE THE TEAM WITH THE BEST COMBINED STABLEFORD SCRATCH SCORES. IN EACH OF THE AGE CATEGORIES THERE WILL BE A TROPHY PRESENTED TO THE OVERALL TEAM CHAMPIONS. THESE CHAMPIONS WILL BE DEEMED THE SCHOOLS CUP CHAMPIONS FOR THE YEAR. IN CASE OF A TIE THERE WILL BE A COUNTBACK (AS PER COUNTBACK RULES BELOW) ON THE LAST COMPETITORS SCORECARD FROM THE TIMESHEET.

DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS. THE GIRLS CATEGORY
CHAMPIONS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE GROSS SCORE.

PRIZES & TOUR LEADERBOARD POINTS WILL BE PRESENTED AT
EACH EVENT. THE OVERALL ORDER OF MERIT POINTS LEADER AT
THE END OF EACH TOUR ACROSS ALL AGE CATEGORIES WILL
RECEIVE A TAKE HOME TROPHY AND PRIZE, ALONG WITH BEING

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

THE OVERALL AGE CATEGORY CHAMPIONS WHO ACCUMLATE THE MOST LEADERBOARD POINTS AT THE END OF OUR WINTER, SPRING, SUMMER & AUTUMN TOURS WILL BE INVITED TO COMPETE IN THE 'CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS' WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP.

IF A COMPETITOR HAS PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED THE NEXT COMPETITOR IN LINE WILL GAIN QUALIFICATION. ADDITIONAL QUALIFYING EVENTS WILL ALSO TAKE PLACE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THESE WILL BE ANNOUNCED ON SOCIAL MEDIA.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS IN THE 'CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS' IS STRICTLY LIMITED WITH COMPETITORS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD TAKING PART. PLEASE NOTE AN INVITE DOESNT GUARANTEE A PLACE IN THE EVENT, EACH QUALIFIER MUST REGISTER AS SOON AS ENTRIES GO LIVE.

WORLD AMATEUR GOLF RANKING EVENTS (WAGR)

THE 'FLOGAS IRISH JUNIOR OPEN ELITE TOUR' IS A SERIES OF MIXED (MEN AND LADIES) 54 HOLE WAGR TOURNAMENTS FOR PLAYERS AGED 25 OR UNDER ON THE DATE OF THE TOUR'S FIRST EVENT. THESE EVENTS ARE SCRATCH TOURNAMENTS DESIGNED FOR THE ELITE GOLFERS. EACH PLAYER CAN PARTICIPATE IN AS MANY OR AS FEW EVENTS AS THEY WISH.

PRIZES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE TOP 3 COMPETITORS AT EACH EVENT WITH THE OVERALL CHAMPION GETTING RANKED ON WAGR IF THEY ARENT ALREADY ON IT. IF A CHAMPION SCORES 3 ROUNDS UNDER PAR AT AN EVENT THEY WILL RECEIVE A £700 CASH BONUS.

LEADERBOARD POINTS (SEE BELOW) WILL BE PRESENTED TO EACH PLAYER AT AN EVENT WITH THE OVERALL LEADERBOARD CHAMPION AT THE END OF THE TOUR RECEIVING THE TOM MCKIBBEN TROPHY AND £700 CASH THANKS TO OUR SPONSORS THE AJC GROUP. THIS PRIZE MONEY IS THE MAXIMUM PRIZE AN AMATEUR CAN WIN.

RULES & REGULATIONS

FORMAT: EACH PLAYER WILL PLAY THEIR DESIGNATED HOLES, MARKING THEIR SCORECARD AS STROKE PLAY. A MAXIMUM SCORE OF 8 WILL APPLY FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY. ONCE THE MAXIMUM HAS BEEN REACHED PLEASE LIFT YOUR BALL AND PUT 8 ON YOUR SCORECARD.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: DEVICES THAT MEASURE DISTANCES ARE PERMITTED.

CADDIES: NO CADDIES ARE ALLOWED FOR COMPETITORS AGED 12 OR OVER. ANY COMPETITOR 11 OR UNDER CAN HAVE A CADDY BUT THERE IS STRICTLY NO COACHING, ADVISE, OR YARDAGES TO BE GIVEN. ALL A CADDY CAN DO IS CARRY OR PUSH THE CLUBS. CADDIES ARE ALSO NOT ALLOWED ON THE GREENS. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THIS WILL RESULT IN A 2 SHOT PENALTY FOR EACH BREACH. THIS HAS BEEN PUT IN PLAY TO HELP THE SPEED OF PLAY. UNDER 9'S MUST HAVE A CADDY.

PACE OF PLAY: EACH PLAYER MUST PLAY WITHOUT UNDUE DELAY, WHICH IS DEFINED AS TAKING NO MORE THAN 45 SECONDS TO PLAY A SHOT. WHEN IT IS DETERMINED THAT A GROUP IS BEHIND TIME, OR OUT OF POSITION ON THE GOLF COURSE THE GROUP WILL BE WARNED AND ASKED TO SPEED UP PLAY. IF THE GROUP CONTINUES TO FALL BEHIND EACH MEMBER OF THE GROUP MAY BE TIMED. IF A PLAYER TAKES MORE THAN THE ALLOCATED TIME, HE OR SHE MAY BE SUBJECT TO A PENALTY. FIRST OFFENSE, WARNING; SECOND OFFENSE; ONE STROKE PENALTY; SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES; DISQUALIFICATION.

CODE OF CONDUCT: VIOLATIONS INCLUDE - ABUSIVE LANGUAGE, CLUB THROWING, CHEATING, DISRESPECT OF VOLUNTEERS OR OFFICIALS, ABUSE TO THE GOLF COURSE OR THE FACILITIES, LITTERING, OR ANY OTHER CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER. THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISMISS ANY PLAYER, CADDIE OR SPECTATOR AT ANY TIME DURING AN EVENT.

RESULT OF THE COMPETITION: WHEN ALL THE SCORES HAVE BEEN POSTED ON THE OFFICIAL SCOREBOARD AND APPROVED BY THOSE IN ATTENDANCE, THE RESULT OF THE EVENT IS DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED UNLESS DUE TO A RULES VIOLATION OR GENUINE MISTAKE.

HOW TO DECIDE TIES: TIES FOR ALL PRIZES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE BEST SCORE ON THE FINAL 9, 6, 3 AND 1 HOLES , OR LAST 6, 3 AND 1 HOLES FOR THE UNDER 9 EVENT. FOR ANY TWO DAY EVENTS THE BEST SCORE ON THE FINAL 18, 9, 6, 3 AND 1 HOLES, OR FINAL 9, 6, 3 AND 1 HOLES FOR THE UNDER 9 EVENT WILL DECIDE.

IF THERE IS A TIE IN ANY OF OUR OVERALL END OF TOUR PRIZES (APART FROM THE ELITE TOUR) THE WINNER WILL BE THE PERSON WHO FINISHES IN THE HIGHEST GROSS POSITION IN THEIR AGE CATEGORY AT THE FINAL EVENT. IF THERE IS A TIE ON THIS, IT WILL REVERT BACK TO THE PREVIOUS EVENT AND SO ON UNTIL WE FIND A WINNER.

TIES IN THE ELITE TOUR WILL BE DECIDED BY THE FINAL 18, 9, 6, 3 AND 1 HOLES WITH A PLAY OFF DECIDING THE OVERALL CHAMPION.

IF THERE IS A TIE IN THE OVERALL TOM MCKIBBIN LEADERBOARD A PLAYOFF WILL DETERMINE THE CHAMPION, UNLESS ONLY ONE OF THE PLAYERS IN THIS TIE IS COMPETING AT THE FINAL EVENT, IN WHICH CASE THIS PERSON WILL BE DEEMED THE OVERALL CHAMPION.

SIGNAL FOR SUSPENSION AND RESUMPTION OF PLAY (LIGHTING): IF PLAY IS TO BE SUSPENDED, ONE LONG SIREN OR HORN BLAST WILL SUSPEND PLAY. PLEASE TAKE SHELTER OR COME OFF THE GOLF COURSE. TWO LONG SIRENS WILL RECOMMENCE PLAY.

SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT: PARTICIPATION DURING TOURNAMENT PLAY CAN BE DANGEROUS. A PLAYER MAY DISCONTINUE PLAY IF HE/SHE BELIEVES THERE ARE DANGEROUS WEATHER CONDITIONS (LIGHTNING, ETC) OR OTHER GOOD REASON SUCH AS ILLNESS. SEEK SHELTER OR MEDICAL HELP WHEN THESE CONDITIONS ARISE.

HANDICAP MAXIMUMS : NO HANDICAP LIMITS FOR AGES 12 AND ABOVE. ALL COMPETITORS AGED 12 OR OVER MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL HANDICAP.

FOR THE U11 AGE CATEGORY ONLY COMPETITORS THAT HAVE AN OFFICIAL WHS HANDICAP CAN COMPETE FOR THE NETT PRIZES. ANY COMPETITOR WITHOUT AN OFFICIAL HANDICAP CAN ONLY COMPETE FOR THE GROSS PRIZES.

NO HANDICAPS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY

HANDICAP REDUCTION: IF ANY COMPETITOR SCORES TWO ROUNDS IN A ROW AT OUR EVENTS UNDER A NETT SCORE OF 59 AND WINS A PRIZE BOTH TIMES, THEIR HANDICAP WILL BE REDUCED BY 5 SHOTS ON THE THIRD EVENT. IF THEY SCORE UNDER 59 ON THE THIRD EVENT, THEIR HANDICAP WILL REDUCE BY A FURTHER 5 SHOTS FOR THEIR FORTH EVENT AND SO ON

PLEASE BE AWARE OF OTHERS NEAR YOU AT ALL TIMES ON THE GOLF COURSE AND PRACTICE AREA. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT YOU MAY GET STRUCK BY A CLUB OR BALL HIT BY SOMEONE ELSE. WHEN RIDING IN A GOLF CART, PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURERS SAFETY NOTICES AT ALL TIMES. RIDING IN A CART OR BEING STRUCK WITH A CLUB OR BALL CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH. ALL COMPETITORS, CADDIES AND SPECTATORS VENTURE ONTO THE GOLF FACILITIES AT THEIR OWN RISK. THE IRISH JUNIOR OPEN IS NOT LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTS OR ACCIDENTS WHILST AT OUR EVENTS.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED, OR TRANSFERRED IF A PLAYER CANCELS THEIR ENTRY FROM 3 WEEKS TO THE EVENT DATE. IN THE EVENT THAT A TOURNAMENT HAS TO BE RESCHEDULED ALL ENTRIES WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE NEW DATE AND COMPETITORS CAN REMAIN IN THE NEW DATE, OR RECEIVE AN EVENT CREDIT FOR ANOTHER EVENT INSIDE A ONE YEAR WINDOW. REFUND REQUESTS PRIOR TO THE 3 WEEK BEFORE AN EVENT WINDOW WILL BE SUBJECT TO A 10% ADMINISTRATION FEE. ENTRY REQUESTS AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE WILL BE SUBJECT TO AN ADDITIONAL 10% LATE ENTRY FEE. IN THE EVENT OF WEATHER CAUSING A DELAY TO OUR TOURNAMENT, THE PRIZE WINNERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE LEAST AMOUNT OF HOLES ANY COMPETITOR HAS PLAYED IN THEIR RESPECTED AGE CATEGORY PROVIDED ALL THE FIELD IN THAT AGE GROUP HAS PLAYED A MINIMUM OF 9 HOLES OR 6 HOLES FOR THE UNDER 9'S. IF THERE IS A TIE ON THESE SCORES THE FINAL 3, 2 OR 1 HOLES WILL DECIDE THE CHAMPION.
