12-19 YEAR OLDS  
MUST BE A MEMBER OF A GOLF CLUB

UNDER 11'S  
NO HANDICAP OR GOLF CLUB MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED

DISCOUNTED ENTRIES CLOSE THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO AN EVENT  
WITH THE DRAW AVAILABLE ONE WEEK PRIOR VIA THE TOURNAMENT  
MANAGEMENT SECTION OF THE WEBSITE

ENTRY FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE OR TRANSFERRABLE 3 WEEKS  
FROM THE START OF AN EVENT. IF ANY EVENT IS CANCELLED DUE TO  
ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS, OR ANY OTHER VALID REASON,  
THE ENTRY FEES WILL AUTOMATICALLY TRANSFER TO A  
RESCHEDULED DATE. CANCELLATION REQUESTS PRIOR TO 3 WEEKS  
FROM AN EVENT WILL HAVE A 10% CHARGE TO COVER MERCHANT  
FEES. ENTRY REQUESTS AFTER 3 WEEKS FROM AN EVENT WILL HAVE  
AN ADDITIONAL 10% FEE

# SCHOOLS CUP

## INDIVIDUAL PRIZES

IN EACH AGE CATEGORY TROPHIES, MEDALS OR PRIZES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE TOP 4 COMPETITORS & GIRLS CHAMPION.

FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY THE TOP 4 GROSS SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS & FOR THE UNDER 19 CATEGORIES THE TOP 2 STABLEFORD SCRATCH SCORES AND TOP 2 STABLEFORD SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS.

THE GIRLS CHAMPION IN THE U19 CATEGORIES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE BEST STABLEFORD POINTS & IN THE U9 CATEGORY THE GIRLS CHAMPION WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE TOP GROSS SCORE.

## TEAM PRIZES

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEAM COMPETITION EACH TEAM MUST CONSIST OF 2 PLAYERS, BOTH WITHIN THE SAME AGE CATEGORY AND SCHOOL.

THE WINNING TEAM/S WILL BE THE TEAM WITH THE BEST COMBINED STABLEFORD SCRATCH SCORES. IN EACH OF THE AGE CATEGORIES THERE WILL BE A TROPHY PRESENTED TO THE OVERALL TEAM CHAMPIONS. THESE CHAMPIONS WILL BE DEEMED THE SCHOOLS CUP CHAMPIONS FOR THE YEAR. IN CASE OF A TIE THERE WILL BE A COUNTBACK (AS PER COUNTBACK RULES BELOW) ON THE LAST COMPETITORS SCORECARD FROM THE TIMESHEET.

# **JUNIOR TOUR EVENT PRIZES**

IN EACH AGE CATEGORY THERE TROPHIES, MEDALS OR PRIZES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE TOP 4 COMPETITORS & GIRLS CHAMPION.

FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY THE TOP 4 GROSS SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS & FOR THE UNDER 19 CATEGORIES THE TOP 2 GROSS AND TOP 2 NETT SCORES WILL DETERMINE THE PRIZE WINNERS. THE GIRLS CATEGORY CHAMPIONS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE GROSS SCORE.

PRIZES & TOUR LEADERBOARD POINTS WILL BE PRESENTED AT EACH EVENT. THE OVERALL ORDER OF MERIT POINTS LEADER AT THE END OF EACH TOUR ACROSS ALL AGE CATEGORIES WILL RECEIVE A TAKE HOME TROPHY AND PRIZE, ALONG WITH BEING CROWNED THE OVERALL TOUR CHAMPION

IF A COMPETITOR HAS PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED THE NEXT COMPETITOR IN LINE WILL GAIN QUALIFICATION. ADDITIONAL QUALIFYING EVENTS WILL ALSO TAKE PLACE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THESE WILL BE ANNOUNCED ON SOCIAL MEDIA.

## WORLD AMATEUR GOLF RANKING EVENTS (WAGR)

THE 'FLOGAS IRISH JUNIOR OPEN ELITE TOUR' IS A SERIES OF MIXED (MEN AND LADIES) 54 HOLE WAGR TOURNAMENTS FOR PLAYERS AGED 25 OR UNDER ON THE DATE OF THE TOUR'S FIRST EVENT. THESE EVENTS ARE SCRATCH TOURNAMENTS DESIGNED FOR THE ELITE GOLFERS. EACH PLAYER CAN PARTICIPATE IN AS MANY OR AS FEW EVENTS AS THEY WISH.

PRIZES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE TOP 3 COMPETITORS AT EACH EVENT WITH THE OVERALL CHAMPION GETTING RANKED ON WAGR IF THEY AREN'T ALREADY ON IT. IF A CHAMPION SCORES 3 ROUNDS UNDER PAR AT AN EVENT THEY WILL RECEIVE A £700 CASH BONUS.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

## 1. FORMAT OF PLAY

EACH PLAYER IN THE UNDER 19, 14 & 11 CATEGORIES WILL PLAY THEIR DESIGNATED NUMBER OF HOLES IN STROKE PLAY FORMAT AND MUST RECORD THEIR SCORE ACCURATELY ON THEIR SCORECARD. FROM TIME TO TIME WE MAY PLAY STABLEFORD BUT EACH COMPETITOR WILL BE TOLD ON THE FIRST TEE.

FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY THE EVENTS WILL ALWAYS BE STROKEPLAY. A MAXIMUM SCORE OF 8 APPLIES PER HOLE. ONCE A SCORE OF 8 HAS BEEN REACHED, THE PLAYER MUST LIFT THEIR BALL AND RECORD 8 ON THE SCORECARD.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES THAT MEASURE DISTANCE ONLY ARE PERMITTED.

## 2. CADDIES

NO CADDIES ARE PERMITTED FOR COMPETITORS COMPETING IN THE ELITE TOUR, UNDER 19 OR 14 JUNIOR TOUR CATEGORIES

COMPETITORS AGED 11 AND UNDER MAY HAVE A CADDIE. CADDIES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM:

- \* PROVIDING COACHING OR ADVICE
- \* GIVING YARDAGES
- \* READING GREENS
- \* ENTERING THE PUTTING GREEN

CADDIES MAY ONLY CARRY OR PUSH CLUBS.

UNDER 9 COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A CADDIE.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN A TWO SHOT PENALTY PER BREACH. THESE RULES ARE IN PLACE TO SUPPORT PACE OF PLAY.

## 3. PACE OF PLAY

PLAYERS MUST PLAY WITHOUT UNDUE DELAY. A MAXIMUM OF 45 SECONDS IS PERMITTED TO PLAY A SHOT. IF A GROUP FALLS BEHIND TIME OR OUT OF POSITION, A WARNING WILL BE ISSUED. CONTINUED DELAY MAY RESULT IN PLAYERS BEING TIMED INDIVIDUALLY.

PENALTIES:

- \* FIRST OFFENCE: WARNING
- \* SECOND OFFENCE: ONE STROKE PENALTY
- \* SUBSEQUENT OFFENCES: DISQUALIFICATION

#### **4. CODE OF CONDUCT**

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR INCLUDES (BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO):

- \* ABUSIVE LANGUAGE
- \* CLUB THROWING
- \* CHEATING
- \* DISRESPECT TOWARDS VOLUNTEERS OR OFFICIALS
- \* ABUSE OF THE GOLF COURSE OR FACILITIES
- \* LITTERING
- \* ANY CONDUCT DEEMED UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISMISS ANY PLAYER, CADDIE, OR SPECTATOR AT ANY TIME.

#### **5. RESULT OF COMPETITION**

ONCE ALL SCORES HAVE BEEN POSTED ON THE OFFICIAL SCOREBOARD AND APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE, THE RESULT IS DEEMED FINAL, UNLESS AMENDED DUE TO A RULES VIOLATION OR GENUINE SCORING ERROR.

#### **6. TIES**

SINGLE DAY JUNIOR TOUR EVENTS:

TIES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE BEST SCORE OVER THE FINAL 9, 6, 3, AND 1 HOLES.

UNDER 9 TIES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE LAST 6, 3, AND 1 HOLES.

TWO DAY JUNIOR TOUR EVENTS:

TIES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE BEST SCORE OVER THE FINAL 18, 9, 6, 3, AND 1 HOLES.

UNDER 9 TIES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE FINAL 9, 6, 3, AND 1 HOLES.

END OF EACH SEASONAL JUNIOR TOUR PRIZES:

THE WINNER WILL BE THE PLAYER WHO FINISHES IN THE HIGHEST GROSS POSITION IN THEIR AGE CATEGORY AT THE FINAL EVENT. IF STILL TIED, RESULTS WILL REVERT TO THE PREVIOUS EVENT(S) UNTIL A WINNER IS DETERMINED.

ELITE TOUR:

TIES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE FINAL 18, 9, 6, 3, AND 1 HOLES. A PLAYOFF WILL DETERMINE THE OVERALL CHAMPION IF REQUIRED.

TOM MCKIBBIN ELITE TOUR LEADERBOARD:

A PLAYOFF WILL DETERMINE THE CHAMPION UNLESS ONLY ONE TIED PLAYER IS COMPETING IN THE FINAL EVENT, IN WHICH CASE THAT PLAYER WILL BE DECLARED THE OVERALL CHAMPION.

## **8. SAFETY**

PARTICIPATION IN TOURNAMENT GOLF CARRIES INHERENT RISKS.

PLAYERS MAY DISCONTINUE PLAY IF THEY BELIEVE THERE ARE DANGEROUS CONDITIONS (E.G. LIGHTNING) OR DUE TO ILLNESS. APPROPRIATE SHELTER OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE SHOULD BE SOUGHT IMMEDIATELY.

ALL COMPETITORS, CADDIES, AND SPECTATORS ENTER GOLF FACILITIES AT THEIR OWN RISK.

THE IRISH JUNIOR OPEN SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY, OR ACCIDENT EXCEPT WHERE CAUSED BY PROVEN NEGLIGENCE.

## **9. HANDICAP REQUIREMENTS**

- \* NO HANDICAP LIMIT FOR AGES 12 AND ABOVE; AN OFFICIAL HANDICAP IS REQUIRED.
- \* UNDER 11 COMPETITORS MUST HOLD AN OFFICIAL WHS HANDICAP TO COMPETE FOR NETT PRIZES.
- \* COMPETITORS WITHOUT AN OFFICIAL HANDICAP MAY COMPETE FOR GROSS PRIZES ONLY.
- \* NO HANDICAP IS REQUIRED FOR THE UNDER 9 CATEGORY.

## **10. HANDICAP ADJUSTMENTS**

IF A COMPETITOR RECORDS TWO CONSECUTIVE NETT SCORES OF 59 OR BETTER AND WINS A PRIZE AT BOTH EVENTS, THEIR HANDICAP WILL BE REDUCED BY 5 STROKES FOR THE NEXT EVENT.

IF A NETT SCORE UNDER 59 IS RECORDED AGAIN, A FURTHER 5-STROKE REDUCTION WILL APPLY FOR THE SUBSEQUENT EVENT.

## **EVENT CANCELLATION, POSTPONEMENT & FORCE MAJEURE**

### **11. CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR REASONABLE CONTROL**

IF A TOURNAMENT CANNOT PROCEED ON ITS SCHEDULED DATE DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE ORGANISER'S REASONABLE CONTROL — INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GOLF COURSE CLOSURE, ADVERSE WEATHER, SAFETY CONCERNS, OR GOVERNMENT RESTRICTIONS — THE ORGANISER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO POSTPONE OR RESCHEDULE THE EVENT.

### **12. ENTRY FEE POLICY**

WHERE AN EVENT IS POSTPONED OR RESCHEDULED DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE ORGANISER'S REASONABLE CONTROL, ENTRY FEES WILL AUTOMATICALLY TRANSFER TO THE RESCHEDULED DATE.

IF THE NEW DATE IS UNSUITABLE, THE ENTRY FEE MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER TOURNAMENT WITHIN EIGHTEEN (18) MONTHS OF THE ORIGINAL EVENT DATE.

ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE IN SUCH CIRCUMSTANCES.

REFUND REQUESTS MADE MORE THAN THREE (3) WEEKS PRIOR TO AN EVENT WILL BE SUBJECT TO A 10% ADMINISTRATION FEE.

REFUND REQUESTS WITHIN THREE (3) WEEKS OF AN EVENT ARE NON REFUNDABLE.

LATE ENTRIES AFTER THE PUBLISHED CLOSING DATE (3 WEEKS BEFORE AN EVENT) WILL INCUR AN ADDITIONAL 10% LATE ENTRY FEE.

### **13. REDUCED PLAY DUE TO WEATHER**
